CALL TO ORDER:

At 12:57 pm the special meeting of the town board was called to order with the pledge of allegiance.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss efficiency planning to meet requirements of the property tax freeze and to appoint a temporary code enforcement officer.

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Colesante made the motion to accept the resignation of Mr. Illingworth as Planning Development and Code Enforcement Director and appointment of Mr. Illingworth as part-time Code Enforcement Officer. This will be at a rate of \$20 an hour for approximately 10 - 15 hours per week until a replacement can be found. Mr. Metzger seconded the motion.

Discussion then turned to the property tax freeze. Mr. Colesante has contacted the Association of Towns, and Mr. Metzger has gone over the budget numbers. Based on this information and the budget cuts the Town has already implemented, the Town will not benefit from working with the county to meet the tax freeze requirements.

Mr. Moran made the motion the Town of Constantia will singularly and without the County of Oswego meet the requirements of the property tax freeze as outlined by the State of New York. Mr. Metzger seconded the motion.
