Project Description: The applicant proposes to install and operate the Bernhards Bay Water District along various roads in the Town of Constantia. During construction the following regulated NYS Freshwater Wetland areas will be impacted; the Adjacent Area to MA-1 along Lower Road, the Adjacent Area to PL-16 along Johnson Road, and the Adjacent Area to PL-49 along Railroad Street. Streams along the following roads will be directionally bored under to avoid impacts; Lower Road, Johnson Road, and Rt 49 near Railroad Road and Martin Drive. Erosion and sediment controls will be required during construction to prevent contravention of water quality standards.

Availability of Application Documents: Filed application documents, and Department draft permits where applicable, are available for inspection during normal business hours at the address of the contact person. To ensure timely service at the time of inspection, it is recommended that an appointment be made with the contact person.

State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) Determination Project is a Type I action and will not have a significant effect on the environment. A coordinated review with other involved agencies was performed and a Negative Declaration is on file.
